






What is ICD-10?

- On **October 1, 2014**, the ICD-9 code sets will be replaced by ICD-10 code sets.
- The transition to ICD-10 is required for everyone.
- ICD-10 codes will allow for greater specificity and exactness in describing a patient's diagnosis and in classifying inpatient procedures.
- Codes used are date of service driven

ICD-10 Timeline




1st Medicare National Testing Week

- The first Medicare Testing Week is complete and successful! Noridian conducted testing with various EDI submitters during this week to verify compliance and editing logistics within the Noridian EDI front-end.
- Although claim volumes were lower than anticipated, EDI claims processing was a success.
- EDISS is allowing continued front-end testing for Medicare submitters until further notification.

Testing Requirements

- Must be established electronic submitters, with active Medicare submitter IDs, and capable of receiving electronic remittance advices (ERAs)
- Providers who submit through a clearinghouse will have to work with their clearinghouse to test
- Vendors cannot volunteer to test directly because they do not have a submitter ID, must work with a chosen submitter to test



Testing Requirements Cont.

- All vendor and practice management software needed to test has been updated and internally tested prior to conducting end-to-end testing with Medicare
- Able to submit future dated claims
- Able to provide the National Provider Identifiers (NPIs) and beneficiary Health Insurance Claim Numbers (HICNs) they will use for test claims when requested by the MAC

Limited End-to-End Testing

- When: July 21-25
- Registration closed March 24th
- Change Request (CR) 8602 will allow for a small subset of Medicare claims submitters to test with MACs and the Common Electronic Data Interchange (CEDI) contractor to demonstrate that CMS systems are ready for the ICD-10 implementation. This additional testing effort will further ensure a successful transition to ICD-10.
- Includes the submission of test claims to CMS with ICD-10 codes and the provider's receipt of a Remittance Advice (RA) that explains the adjudication of the claims

End-to-End Testing cont.

- Able to successfully submit claims containing ICD-10 codes to the Medicare FFS claims systems
- CMS software changes made to support ICD-10 result in appropriately adjudicated claims (based on the pricing data used for testing purposes)
- Accurate RAs are produced
- Commercial Submitters should verify their End-to-End submission options with the appropriate payers.


Updating PC-ACE Pro32

- In order for a PC-ACE Pro32 user to be able to send ICD-10, they will need to complete specific steps in their software.

NOTE: this is a temporary update and will need to be switched back once testing is completed. Production files cannot be sent with ICD-10 data until October 1,2014.

Updating PC-ACE Pro32 cont.


1. Select FILE.
2. Select Preferences.
3. Hit "Shift 7"
4. Select the System (3) tab.
5. Check the box "Enable support for ICD-10 diagnosis and procedure codes"


