Billing Chiropractic Claims Electronically


When billing chiropractic claims electronically, the claim must contain an initial treatment date.

Implementation Guide Specifics

- Initial Treatment Date The Initial Treatment Date (ITD) is the date of the initial treatment (visit) or the date of exacerbation of the existing condition. It is not the first date that a chiropractor saw the patient in their office.
 - o Example: DTP*454*D8*20040615~
 - o The ITD is required on all claims involving spinal manipulation.
 - o The ITD is submitted in Loop 2300 (Claim Information).
 - o The ITD is reported in a DTP segment in the format CCYYMMDD.
 - The Date/Time Qualifier must be submitted as 454.
